3. What is the first syllable block?

'rob'

4. Say each sound in the block.

'r' 'o' 'b'

5. What is the second syllable block?

'in'

6. Say each sound in the block.

'i' 'n'

7. Now read each block syllable.

rob in

8. Now blend the syllables together.

robin
