Section A: Comprehension

- Read the questions.
- Read the passage once, then read again.
- Use EVIDENCE/QUOTATIONS from the passage to support your answers.
- Write in full sentences, using appropriate punctuation and spelling. Use POINT-QUOTE-COMMENT/SALAAL structure.
- Write in full sentences, using appropriate punctuation and spelling.
- READ over what you WRITE to ensure it makes sense.
- Look over all the corrections in your English exercise books.
- Learn corrected spellings, punctuation and grammar.

Section B: Creative Writing

- You will be given a title to write about.
- PLAN the structure/events in your story before you begin.
- Make your writing interesting by using description to describe characters and feelings.
- Write about real events rather than imagined events as it is easier to write about.
- Write in full sentences, using appropriate paragraphs, punctuation and spelling.
- Practise writing direct speech using the correct punctuation in order to use it in your story to add variety.
- READ over what you WRITE to ensure it makes sense.
- SPEND most of your TIME on this section and PLANNING is ESSENTIAL.
